

## **Press Visas for Members of the Foreign Media, TV and Radio**

The visa for members of the Foreign Media, Press, and Radio is free.

In order to apply for a visa, the media member has to appear in person at the Consulate General (241 East 49th Street, New York, NY 10017) after receiving an appointment date and time by sending the following documentation to [visas@consuladoperuny.org](mailto:visas@consuladoperuny.org):

- Application form.

- Valid passport (the passport must be at least six months of validity and at least two blank pages)
- Original letter from the media company attesting that the correspondent is accredited to cover information in Peru.
- Air ticket (round trip) or reservation for your trip to Peru.
- Hotel reservation
- One (1) photo, passport size, color and white background
- The Temporary importation form for professional equipment duly filled, if applicable (Important: The list of equipment is only accepted if they are described in the official attached format).
- Visa process: from 7 to 10 business days (Authorization is required from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Peru and temporary permits for the internment of the equipment by Customs)

This Consulate will only issue VISAS for New York State residents. (Residents in other states, please contact the Consulate of Peru in the State of residence: [www.consulado.pe](http://www.consulado.pe))
